## Rector's Message



It is with pride and pleasure that I am associating myself with the pamphlet for the 2016 Annual Prize Giving Ceremony.

To-day we are rewarding the best achievers of 2015 for JKC End of Examinations as well as those for SC and HSC levels. Congratulations to all prize winners and to their parents and good luck to all the other achievers who, unfortunately, are not prize winners to-day. So, better luck next time. My thanks go to all the Educators who have spared no effort to draw the best out of the students.

At the SC level, we have succeeded in maintaining a high pass rate above 98 % but for the 2016 cohort, we are aiming for a 100% pass rate and more students scoring with aggregate 6.

At the HSC level, JKC has got its second laureate in a row (after a break of ten years) and its second Additional Scholarship winner under the Merit & Social criteria. So, congratulations to Maximilien Chong Lee Shing for being the JKC laureate of 2015 for the Technical Side and to Shabaaz Kurmally for being the Scholarship Winner for the Science side. Such performances will undoubtedly give extra motivation to the 2016 HSC cohort to do better. Potential laureates are emerging but no one should rest on their laurels; everyone will have to run the extra mile to make a difference and to walk away with the honours.

The introduction of Art & Design at the Principal level for HSC in 2013 has finally been fruitful with Maximilien being a laureate with the combination Maths-Physics – Art & Design. With the introduction combinations involving Economics & Business Studies and offering English (Main) and French (Main), I think that we are paving the way for further success.

As in previous years, in 2015, too, Kennedians have been shining in many Co & Extra- Curricular activities, e.g., MUN both at Zone & National levels, OMNICANE and Activities organized by the Ministry of Youth & Sports among others. We felt extremely proud when two Kennedians were among the four youth leaders representing Mauritius at the Pan African Youth Leadership Programme in US earlier this year; I have named Maximilien & Duchenne. Along with academic studies, participation in Co & Extra Curricular activities is essential to promote holistic development. Participation in the Duke of Edinburgh Award goes in the same direction. This is why we have chosen to reward the Kennedians for the Bronze Award of 2015 and we look forward to launch the Junior Achievement Award too very soon.

We welcome the intention of the Ministry of Education & HR, TE & SR to convert JKC into an Academy offering subjects in the Science, Technical and SPORTS streams in the context of the Nine Year Schooling. We thank the Ministry for proposing the erection of a new block for Science laboratories instead of renovating the existing ones. However, our new Multi-Purpose Hall is not yet operational due to lack of Staff; the requests made since 2014 are yet to be entertained.

The revival of JKC – which I set as mission to myself when I was posted at JKC in 2013 – is well on track and will be taken much further ahead irrespective of whether I remain at JKC or not for Kennedians have now realized their potential and that they are second to none.
